ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for admission to the MCS program, applicants must have:

- a bachelor's degree (or an equivalent qualification in any discipline, to be evaluated by the program's Admissions Committee)
- at least five (5) years' work experience preferably with at least two (2) years' managerial experience

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Complete your [online application form](#) in AIM Portal.
2. Send your CV/Resume and Transcript of Academic Records/Marksheets to mcs@aim.edu. Should you also have any of the remaining application documents ready, you may upload them early to expedite your application:
 - Application essay answers (Student Recruitment Coordinator will email you the questions once your online application form is received).
 - Copy of valid passport's ID page or valid government ID (for Filipinos only)
 - One (1) professional recommendation (download template [here](#)) or Certificate of Business Registration for self-employed applicants
3. Send your admissions test result of any of the following to mcs@aim.edu:
 - GMAT
 - GRE
 - NMAT by GMAC
 - CAT / XAT (for Indian Applicants)
 - AIM Admissions Test (AIMAT; if none of the above is available) – email us at mcs@aim.edu to schedule your AIMAT
 - AIMAT Fee is **USD 100 USD (PHP 5,000)**. See payment options and AIM bank details [here](#). Please send us a copy of the deposit slip to verify the payment made and we will issue an Official Receipt in return.
4. Undergo an admissions interview (shortlisted applicants only). Our student recruitment coordinator will schedule you for an interview once you passed the initial assessment.
5. Submit your pending requirements, if there are any, to complete your application.
6. Await admissions result. Results will be sent via email and the official admissions letter can be accessed via your AIM Portal.
7. Reserve your slot for enrollment
 - Pay a **USD 1,000 registration fee** which will be deducted from the total program fee.
8. Apply for loans, if applicable

**Note: Loan applications will only be processed once a candidate has passed the MCS admissions process*
